



Rules and Regulations

To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone, please adhere to the following rules and regulations while on the boat:

1. No Drugs and Alcohol: The use of illegal drugs is strictly prohibited on board.

While moderate consumption of alcohol is allowed, intoxication will not be tolerated. Passengers who appear intoxicated will be asked to stop from drinking further and may be removed from the boat at the next docking point without refund.

Passengers are encouraged to drink responsibly and be always mindful of their behavior.

2. Behavior and Conduct: Loud and disruptive behavior, including shouting, is not allowed. Passengers are expected to maintain a considerate and peaceful demeanor.

Be courteous and respectful to any crew members. Harassment, bullying, or aggressive behavior will not be tolerated.

Passengers must always wear appropriate clothing. Swimwear is allowed in designated areas only. Shirtless or inappropriate dressing is not permitted during the boat trip.

Follow all instructions given by the crew and staff. They are here to ensure your safety and enjoyment.

3. Safety Instructions: Follow all safety instructions that may be provided by the crew at any time during the boat trip.

4. Safety Equipment: The boat is provided with safety equipment, including life jackets for all onboarding passengers.

5. Restricted Areas: Access to certain areas of the boat is restricted to crew members only. Passengers must respect these restrictions if giving by the crew members.

6. No Littering: Dispose of trash in designated bins. Help us keep the boat and waterways clean. Do not throw anything overboard. Respect marine life and the natural environment.
